Get free measles, mumps and rubella vaccination. Give your consent?

Dear parent/guardian,

Your child can receive a vaccine against **measles, mumps and rubella** at school.

- The vaccine protects **against three diseases**.
- Your child may have already had this vaccine when they were a baby. This is a second dose.

This vaccination is free of charge. It is administered by the CLB

Notice: is your child at risk of a severe reaction following the vaccine?

**Severe allergic reaction = swelling of the mouth or throat, and/or difficulty breathing, and/or heart problems*

About measles, mumps and rubella



Measles gives fever and rash. Sometimes there is an earinfection or pneumonia. Very occasionally there is also encephalitis. This can be fatal or cause permanent damage. Measles is very contagious

Mumps can cause meningitis or testicular inflammation.

Rubella causes fever and a rash. It is particularly dangerous for pregnant women, can lead to miscarriage or birth defects in the baby. We vaccinate boys and girls to stop the spread of this disease.



The vaccine is administered as **a single injection** into the arm.



This school year, we are administering this second dose **to children aged around 7 (second grade) and 9 (fourth grade)**.



The vaccine **is very safe**. Vaccines can cause side effects. The chance of this vaccine causing a serious side effect is very small. Mild side effects immediately after vaccination usually go away on their own after a few days (fever, pain or **redness and swelling at the injection site**). **Sometimes side effects occur 5 to 12 days** after vaccination (fever, headache, joint pain or a rash). These also go away on their own after a few.



The vaccine **is completely free of charge**.



The vaccination is administered by **a doctor or nurse** from the CLB. You can also go to your doctor (GP). In that case, you will have to pay your doctor.
